2024 Oak Hills HOA Assessments

The last time assessments increased was 2018. Unfortunately due the effects of inflation, we now need to increase assessments effective January 1, 2024. The new assessment will increase from \$120/bimonthly to \$135/bimonthly. Monthly it is a \$7.50 increase. Current monthly rate is \$60.00 and effective January 1, 2024 it will be \$67.50 monthly.

If you live on a private drive, the assessments listed below will be in addition to the regular assessments:

Arrowleaf Private Drive - \$70 bimonthly

Clover Trail Drive - \$70 bimonthly

Sandbur Drive - \$90 bimonthly

Shadow Oak (which includes Mimosa Ct and Madras Ct) - \$70 bimonthly


The increased amount will start with the billing on January 1, 2024. Please ensure that the correct new amount is being paid.
