Re: 2026 Board Member Election

Dear Homeowners,

It is time to elect members to the Oak Hills Homeowners Association Board. **There are 4 open seats to be filled and 3 Board members whose term is ending.**

The Association needs new members and works best when full. Are you interested in affecting change in our community? Sitting on the board of your homeowner's association is a rewarding way to get involved in your community, get to know your neighbors, and personally ensure that your property values are preserved and protected – for the immediate future and in the long run.

All homeowners are invited to run for a position on the Board. The Board meets in open meetings on the third Wednesday of each month and in Executive Sessions as necessary. It is expected that any Board member will be present at no less than nine (9) scheduled Board meetings within the calendar year.

The Board is a volunteer position, and members meet once a month to discuss matters that affect all homeowners. One of the ongoing projects before the Board is the continued maintenance and improvement of the common areas.

The votes will be counted at the Annual Meeting on May 19, 2026. The location will be available 3 months prior to the event.

If, at the close of the time period for making nominations (2/20/26), there are the same number or fewer qualified candidates as there are board positions to be filled, then the OHHA Board of Directors may, after voting to do so, seat the qualified candidates by acclamation without balloting.
