HAVE YOUR VOICE HEARD JUNE 5 PRUNEDALE LIBRARY NEW ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW POLICY

Dear Fellow Homeowner:

You received a copy of the new policy that was composed by the Architectural Review Policy Committee. This is something new for our community but long overdue. The CC&R's states "The Architectural Review Committee shall consist of no less than three (3) nor more than five (5) members and shall be appointed by the Board and shall serve a term of one (1) year." There has always been a requirement to appoint a committee, but it was just never done. After a lot of time and effort the ARC committee has developed a policy which was approved by the Board to send to the members.

The policy has been vetted by an attorney; however, this is only a first major step. Unlike the CC&R's and By-laws which require a majority approval by the general membership, the ARC Policy can be amended by a simple majority vote of the Board.

This policy will be enforced fairly and when necessary, fines will be levied on those who refuse to follow the requirements of the policy. It is reasonable and very few homeowners should have objections to the policy.

The Board wants to know your opinions since you have had time to review the policy. We look forward to meeting with you at the Prunedale Library Community Room or on Zoom on June 5 for a town hall meeting where your opinions will be heard and given consideration. The Board will consider all of the input before the final approval of the policy at the June 14 meeting.
