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Greenbelt Access Areas & Paths

The greenbelt which surrounds our homes and neighborhood belongs to the Oak Hills Homeowners Association and the homeowners who live here. This greenbelt, which was set aside for the enjoyment and use of all the homeowners, may be accessed via paths at the end of many streets. Several of these paths have been maintained by the homeowners who live next to them and that maintenance is appreciated since it helps the HOA to keep our dues to a minimum. Unfortunately, there have been some homeowners who took it upon themselves to landscape or block access to a greenbelt access area next to their property.

No homeowner may restrict the access to any portion of the greenbelt or any access path. These areas are for the use of the homeowners for accessing areas of the greenbelt.

Any homeowner wishing to improve the greenbelt area or access path near their home must request permission from the Board of Directors. They must also recognize that any improvements made will become the property of the Association.
